Social Science 3.0 credits - History or other social sciences

Math (plus senior year)3.0 credits - Algebra, Geometry, and Algebra II; senior year math-based course (can be CTE course) or algebra-based science is sufficient (completing Pre-Calculus or higher prior to your senior year can exempt you from the senior year requirement)

Science (at least 2.0 lab) 2.0 credits-At least one of must be in an Algebra-based science course as determined by the school district. One credit must be in: Biology, Chemistry, or Physics

Arts 1.0 credit-1 credit of fine, visual, or performing arts—or 1 additional credit in CADR subject areas

World Languages 2.0 credits-2 credits of the same world language, Native American Language, or American Sign Language
